Recommended Plant List



LANDSCAPE APPROACH

Silos Recreation area will provide both traditional and native landscape areas appropriate for the type and level of use in each development area. The site will be served by a non-potable irrigation system to provide permanent watering for plant and ground cover establishment.

Selected trees, shrubs, forbs and ground covers are intended to be water-conscious and compatible with the local climate. Recommendations listed here are a first step and should be reviewed and re-visited prior to any detailed implementation plans.

Traditional landscape, to include irrigated sod, shade trees and shrubs will exist in the large day-use and event area north of Broadwater Bay. Other small areas of traditional landscape may be included around camper services buildings or day-use shelters.

A dryland, native or native-compatible landscape is planned for the remainder of the site, to include developed day use and camping areas. Establishment of successful ground plane cover in these areas will be critical to reducing erosion, dust and creating a pleasant visitor experience. Seasonal timing of plant installations and seeding will also be crucial to success of the landscape. Detailed development plans for each phase are recommended to address requirements for temporary fencing for visitor access control, wildlife browsing and weed management. Evergreen trees should be placed to maximize use as windbreaks where possible, while mixed with deciduous species to create a diverse tree canopy. Plants may be planted at smaller sizes such as bare root, to allow for over-planting and increase chances of long term success.

Recommended future studies to aid in plant selection and establishment:

- Inventory of successful on-site species.
- Inventory of problematic existing weedy and invasive species.
- Analysis of existing soil conditions to establish required soil amendments.
- Development of a landscape maintenance plan to address growing season maintenance, weed management, supplemental watering needs.
